WALK FOR WARMTH is a statewide effort to promote public awareness concerning people experiencing heat-related emergencies. Locally, Capital Area Community Services, Inc. (CACCS), the non-profit, Community Action Agency serving Eaton, Ingham, Clinton and Shiawassee Counties, sponsors this event. This year, CACCS's 19<sup>th</sup> annual WALK FOR WARMTH will be held on Saturday, February 28<sup>th</sup>. (Registration begins at 8:30 AM at the First Congregational Church, 106 S. Bostwick in Charlotte; the WALK begins at 9:00 AM)

With the dramatic increase in utility costs, local residents' needs have become far greater than service agencies and churches can resolve without additional resources such as WALK FOR WARMTH. Funds are raised through contributions from individuals, civic organizations, businesses, clubs, and church groups and are used to assist residents with home heat related emergencies. **100%** of the funds from the event are used to assist low-income households in the county that it is raised in. Nothing is held back for administrative costs.
